- 1. Take care of my people: cp. Acts 20:28-30/1 Pet. 5
- 2. Be willing to suffer for Christ: John 21:18-19
- 3. Follow Christ in obedience: John 21:19; 14:15, 21, 24

The house built upon the sand hears the word of Christ but does not build their life on it. He who builds his life on the rock is the person who hears and obeys Christ's Word: Matthew 7

4. Love those who belong to Christ: John 13:34 with 1 John 3:16-18

- 5. To love God is to be known by God: 1 Cor. 8:3 contrast to Matt. 7 where Jesus says, "I never knew you".
- 6. The rivals for our love especially in the last days are:
 - Lovers of self
 - Lovers of money
 - Unloving by instinct and nature
 - Lovers of pleasure
 - Not lovers of God
 - 2 Timothy 3:2-4
- 7. We are in danger of loving the world and forsaking Christ as Demas did: 2 Timothy 4:10
- 8. We are in danger of leaving our love for Christ: Rev. 2:1-7
