

Fashionista FAQs

What does my ticket price include?

Food, fellowship, a "swag bag" and new-to-you clothes and/or accessories at no additional cost. You will also have access to vendors, free mini-pampering services and have the opportunity to bid on silent auction items.

Who should come?

Your mom, daughter, sister, favorite auntie, and your best girlfriends. The more sassy swappers, the merrier. Although we've added kids' clothes to the swap this year, this event is for ladies only.

How does a clothing swap work?

You and your friends show up with your used clothing. You are limited to bring one bag of ladies clothes and one bag of children's clothes per person. Drop your clothes at the door (the ones you brought, not the ones you're wearing) and then go eat, mingle, get pampered, bid at the silent action, shop with our vendors — basically, have some fun while we sort the clothes. Then the doors to the swap will open and you get to go "shop" for beautiful new-to-you new pieces.

You mean, I'm supposed to bring my old clothes? What should I bring?

Bring new and/or gently used wardrobe items that you no longer wear or need, freshly laundered; no rips or stains; no undergarments. Please only bring items that are nice enough to lend to a friend. Please separate ladies clothes from kids clothes.

Ladies Clothing: All styles: Classic, Trendy, vintage, sporty and more.

All sizes: Ladies petite to plus sizes (maternity clothes, too.)

All items in your closet: Not just clothing! Don't forget those shoes, scarves, hats, jewelry and accessories that you no longer wear. Your cast-offs may help another woman boost her confidence and/or land a job!

Kids' Clothing: Clothes and shoes only

Sizes: 0 mos. to kids size 14

Will I be able to try clothes on?

Yes, there will be a semi-private dressing area in the ladies clothing swap.

I can't come. May I donate clothes?

This event is a fundraising event during which we exchange clothes with each other, not a clothing drive, per se. If you cannot attend, please donate your clothes directly to your favorite charity.

Will there be child care?

Part of the fun is having a girls' night out. You'll need to fully focus on your swapping strategy, so please make your own arrangements to leave your child(ren) at home.
