



The steadfast love of the Lord never ceases; His mercies never come to an end; They are new every morning; great is Your faithfulness. Lamentations 3:22




I have said these things to you, that in me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation. But take heart; I have overcome the world." John 16:33

1 Peter 5:8



PROTECT YOUR BODY
