

AN EXPLANATION OF

LASTING IMPACT

We have adapted the theme "LASTING IMPACT" based on the principles that we find in 2 Corinthians 9:6-15–giving from the heart without reluctance or pressure, but with joy, leads to abundant blessings from God. Your generous giving not only supplies the needs of the Lord's people but results in thanksgiving to God. Still others will give praise to God. Your obedient generosity in giving to the Lord and sharing with others opens the door for the Gospel of Christ. Thanks be to God for His indescribable gift of grace through Jesus Christ! What an example of giving. What you decide in your heart to give today will have a lasting impact on you, those around you, and future generations. Please join us in this Lasting Impact Program that will affect God's people now and into the future!

The **LASTING IMPACT** campaign is designed with three consecutive levels:

LEVEL 1 - VICTORY: \$650,000 - MORTGAGE AT \$18,000 PER MONTH

This level, when reached, will allow us to pay an additional \$300,000 +/- against the current balance of the mortgage.

LEVEL 2 - CHALLENGE: \$850,000 (Level 1 + Level 2 = \$1,500,000)

Added to Level 1, the 2nd Level, when attained, will allow us to do some highly-needed and muchdesired maintenance in the following three areas:

- \$450,000 Café and store front glass at columns
- \$100,000 Remodel the Worship Center lobby
- \$300,000 Ministry Growth, used to increase Valley Bible Church's abilities to grow ministry level

LEVEL 3 - HALLELUJAH: UP TO \$2,930,000 (Level 1 + Level 2 + Level 3 = \$4,430,000)

The amount of Level 3 reflects the balance of the mortgage after the accelerated amount paid on the existing balance from Level 1. All of the funds received above Levels 1 and 2 would go toward the balance of our current mortgage.

We are excited and honored to introduce our new Capital Stewardship Campaign, **LASTING IMPACT!**

This leadership committee has two simple goals: direct you towards God's will through His Word, prayer, and our testimonies; and provide you the opportunity to honor your Savior and serve your community through your sacrifices to our God. We trust that God will continue to lead you, Valley, as He has faithfully done for nearly 50 years now!

1972 Easter Sunday - 120 present First Building Fund offering received \$2,105 **1975-77** Purchased Primrose property in Pinole

1983 Moved to Garretson - May 1983; Obtained 3-year lease on Garretson Middle School



2000 Ground breaking for Worship Center - Sunday 4/16/00. Construction of Worship Center begins.

1973 Purchased Lucas Ave property in Pinole Valley

1971 The work begins with nineteen people in attendance. First service - Sunday 10/3/71 at Holy Ghost Association. Hall in Old Town Pinole



1986 Lease expired - moved to Bay City Auditorium in Rodeo. First official Capital Stewardship Program begins, "Understanding the Harvest"

1974 Renting six other buildings to house ministries. Purchased Holy Ghost Hall at 592 Tennent Avenue, Pinole **1997** (February) 15-year loan paid in full (in 8 years)

1989 Family Life Center completed. Moved in 2/24/89. First service – Sunday 2/26/89



1987 Bayberry (Willow) property obtained; Ground breaking - May 1987. Family Life Center construction begins. **2012–2015** Installed acoustic treatments in WC and new roof on the FLC; painted exterior of FLC; installed 3 new landmark crosses; installed HD video equipment and new sound equipment in WC



2001 Worship Center (WC) completed and dedicated; First Service Sunday 7/22/01; Dedication Sunday 7/29/01

2018–2021 Ministry Growth: Executive Pastor added to staff; Associate Pastor Matt Nicosia, Small Groups oversight; Transition of Founding



Senior Pastor; Celebration of 48 years with Dr. Phillip Howard; Began Christmas in Hercules yearly outreach; Asphalting of Parking lot; Purchased new sound

and video Equipment for Worship Center and Parking lot/Outdoor Services; Remodeling of the Family Life Center preschool and kindergarten class rooms currently under construction; Began planning for VBC's 50th Anniversary Celebration



2004 Office complex/lower classrooms completed; Church staff moves into new office complex. **2011** Celebrated VBC's 40th Anniversary; renegotiated our first loan to reduce interest from 6.25% to 4.49%



2009 Paid off our 10-year, \$1.5 mil 2nd mortgage in April (4 years early!)



2015-2018 Purchased 30' articulating arm lift; installed new lighting and updated stage decor in WC; resurfaced and restriped parking lots; installed security cameras in WC/FLC; installed solar panels on WC/FLC; updated/refurbished youth room, nursery (infant, toddler, and mother's rooms); began FLC lobby/auditorium update

HOW CAN I BE A PART OF THE LASTING IMPACT CAMPAIGN?

To be a part of the campaign is to *prayerfully consider and commit to a sacrificial amount above your regular Ministry Fund giving* for the next three years (beginning May 23, 2021). No effort will be made to tell any person a specific amount required for commitment. Each family should decide its particular commitment after seeking God's guidance in this important decision. *Make your gift a matter of prayer*.

Why is the **LASTING IMPACT** Stewardship Program necessary?

Besides the obvious financial benefit to the ministries of our church that will be met through this program. It is an opportunity to develop generous stewards, through practical stewardship that will have a Lasting Impact. The kind of impact not only for today's needs but also an impact in the lives of future generations. The Lasting Impact program is designed to meet the obligation of our mortgage, which will reduce the balance by over \$300,000 during this three-year program. At the same time, it also provides a way to accelerate the retirement of the mortgage, add a café, make some muchneeded improvements to our facilities and set aside funding to expand our ministries (a more detailed explanation can be found on the inside cover).

How much is our mortgage and what is our monthly payment?

The balance of our current mortgage is just above the \$3,000,000 mark as we begin our program. Our anticipated monthly payment during this program is \$18,000. This payment will allow us to pay over \$300,000 towards the balance of the mortgage during this program.

How does the stewardship program work?

The Lasting Impact Program seeks giving that is **above and beyond your current Ministry Fund giving**. Each family will be asked to prayerfully make a commitment of a sacrificial amount that is above their standard Ministry Fund giving for the next three years, giving first to the Ministry Fund and then towards that **LASTING IMPACT** Program.

Where will the commitments be made?

Commitments will be made at a **Special Event Sunday Service, May 16, 2021**. At the conclusion of the service, an opportunity will be given for each person in attendance to make their individual commitment. Although we encourage everyone to attend this very Special Event, there will be other opportunities for those unable to attend. This Special Event Sunday Service will be followed by a catered luncheon. You do not want to miss this event so plan accordingly.

When can I begin giving my commitment and how will I make my contributions to this stewardship program?

We will officially begin this program on **Sunday**, **May 23rd, 2021 at our Victory Celebration Sunday.** Offering envelopes will be available throughout the program. You can also choose to contribute on line at valleybible.org/give.

Is there a certain amount of money that I will be expected to commit to our program?

No, each individual should prayerfully seek God's guidance and then make a decision about what He would have them commit. The Bible teaches prayerful, generous, sacrificial giving. Please make your gift (commitment) a matter of thoughtful and fervent prayer.

Will we be asked to make our commitments publicly?

No, neither will individual commitments be announced. Because they are involved in the recording of our weekly giving, the only persons who will know your amount are the Church Administrator and his staff.
