Fives Solas

- o **Sola Scriptura** Scripture is God's inspired Word, it is the only inerrant, sufficient, and final authority for the church.
- o **Solus Christus** Christ alone is the basis on which the ungodly are justified in God's sight.
- o **Sola Fide** the believer receives the redemption Christ has accomplished only through faith.
- o **Sola Gratia** all of our salvation, from beginning to end, is by grace and grace alone.
- o *Soli Deo Gloria* only God receives glory for our salvation.
