# FROM OUR LEAD PASTOR DR. PAUL CRANDELL

What a year! 2020 started out with a bang for our family. We were welcoming our fourth child into our family, who was born Dec. 17, 2019. ### **COVID-19 (CORONAVIRUS) APPEARS**

On March 12<sup>th</sup> a decision was made to suspend our March 15<sup>th</sup> Installation Service due to the new coronavirus. Little did we know that this was just the beginning of the virus and its restrictions. The State and County Health Department mandates did not allow us to meet indoors in our facilities for the remainder of the year. Our First Impressions Team, under Ernie Sanchez's leadership, and our Security Team, led by Robert Lendway, also experienced "firsts" in 2020. Because we could no longer meet indoors, these teams transitioned their ministries to greet and protect our guests outdoors. We held several special prayer meetings and worship gatherings in our parking lots, and these teams ensured that our guests could safely meet for much needed fellowship. Because our teams did such a great job at these special services, we were able to hold regular Sunday worship services in our parking lots through the late summer and fall seasons.

Our First Impressions and Security Teams also partnered with VBC Kids and Worship Ministry to host our community for our Candy Kingdom and Christmas in Hercules events. Because these events were forced outdoors this year, First Impressions and Security were needed more than ever. They faithfully welcomed guests with a friendly "hello" and guided them through our parking lots, as people remained safe in their cars while still experiencing the love of Jesus. While braving the cold and rain, these teams helped our church welcome hundreds upon hundreds of vehicles filled with guests.

#### VBC MEN

While many events at VBC were postponed or cancelled in 2020, we were blessed to still get to host 150 men at our "Get into the Game" Men's Conference in early March. Our VBC Men's Ministry Coordinator, Pete Knight, and his team did a phenomenal job organizing this event so men could connect to eat, laugh, sing, learn, and discuss their personal journeys with Jesus. Dr. John Fernandez of Grace Church in Napa was our keynote speaker and he blessed the men of VBC with excellent Bible teaching that challenged all who attended to look to Christ in love, obedience, and service.

Pete Knight also continues to do a great job each Saturday morning with our men using the "Warpath" Bible study series, which provides a safe, encouraging, and challenging environment to help men live out Jesus' commands in purity. Thanks, Pete, for guiding our men and helping them take significant steps in their walks with Christ.

### THANKSGIVING BLESSINGS

One of the greatest privileges each year at Valley Bible is hosting families from our community into our Family Life Center to bless them at Thanksgiving time with a box of food and a turkey. Through we couldn't open up to host this event indoors, we still blessed over 30 families with grocery store gift cards and turkeys as they drove through our "Thanksgiving Blessing" event. ## FINANCIAL OVERVIEW

Total Income received in 2020 was \$3,413,176.74. Of this total, the amount of tithes/offerings were \$2,060,510.10 or 60.4% of all income. Another \$407,272.06 came from miscellaneous sources including campus use fees, lease agreement fees, and federal government funds. The remaining annual income came from ministry operations such as youth events, children's ministry events, and other

operational event transactions. The total expenses incurred during 2020 was \$3,338,691.22. All expenses are broken down into individual ministry areas in order to accurately monitor where expenses occur within the total church operation. As a result, the year 2020 provided a surplus of Income exceeding Expenses for a total of \$74,485.52. Praise the Lord!



## 2021 BUDGET HIGHLIGHTS

When formulating the 2021 church budget, the various ministry leaders were asked to provide their plans for executing their goals for the particular ministry areas they manage. Once these plans were submitted to the Executive Pastor for review, a discussion between the ministry leader and Executive Pastor takes place and the result of that meeting produces a final ministry plan for that area. The Church Administrator then takes all the final plans, puts them together to prepare a budget plan to be submitted to the Elders for review. The Elders review the submitted budget, and after thorough discussion and possibly alterations, they approve the final draft of the 2021 Church Budget.

The overall 2021 church budget is \$550,272 less than the previous year's budget. There are several factors which affected this decline. One is the closure of our Valley Preschool/Daycare that took place in November of 2020 and there is no plan to

reopen the preschool operation during 2021. The Covid-19 virus pandemic concerns affected the planning of many ministry areas which caused eliminating several major events, ie youth camps, retreats, and other types of people gatherings. Finally, our overall expenses have declined due to less use of our facilities, and less personnel. We give praise to God working in and through the people who continue to faithfully support the ministry here at Valley Bible Church. Even during these unusual times when our gathering together has been very limited, our giving has allowed the church to continue to minister to people, support our missionaries around the world, paid all our expense obligations, provide financial aid to those in need. The 2021 Church Budget reflects the most accurate estimation of potential income and expected expenses to occur during the calendar year.
